

ROULETTE RULES

- The ball will be spun in the opposite direction to the wheel.
- Wagers orally declared will be accepted only if accompanied by placing sufficient money or chips on the table to cover the wager, they are called in good time, and are verbally confirmed by the dealer.
- The dealer will help you place your bets if you require assistance, but it is your responsibility to make sure the bets are placed correctly.
- The player must ensure that any instructions given are correctly understood and carried out.
- Partnerships entered into with a view to exceeding the maximum will not be permitted.

HOUSE EDGE

In Roulette the House Edge is achieved by the casino paying slightly less than the true odds. The true odds for single zero Roulette are 36 – 1 since there are 37 numbers in the wheel. Winning bets, however are actually paid at 35 – 1.

Even chance bet – House Edge 1.35%

Bets on the layout – House Edge 2.7%

NEIGHBOURS

Groups of 5 numbers together on the wheel E.g 2, 25, (17), 34, 6. This bet would be called “17 and the Neighbours”.

It is a 5 chip bet.

TIERS

Covering the twelve numbers on the section of the wheel from 27 to 33. This is a 6 chip bet on the splits: 5/8, 10/11, 13/16, 23/24, 27/30, 33/36.

VOISONS DU ZERO

Covering the seventeen numbers on the section of the wheel from 22 to 25. A nine chip bet: 0/2/3 (x2), 4/7, 12/15, 18/21, 19/22, 25/29 (x2) and 32/35.

ORPHELINS

Covering the remaining 8 numbers not included in the tier or Voisons du Zero. A five chip bet 1, 6/9, 14/17, 17/20 and 31/34.

To make these bets, give the correct number of chips to the dealer and announce clearly which bet you have chosen.

The bets will be placed on the “Race Track” which is located on the layout in front of the dealer.

ROULETTE ODDS

If the winning number is Zero, all bets lose, except those that are placed on or associated with Zero. All even money wagers lose half their stake.

THE WHEEL

The wheel is divided into 37 equal segments numbered 0 – 36. These are divided into red and black numbers with the exception of Zero which is green.



SPREAD-BET ROULETTE

- Spread-Bet Roulette transparently generates a bonus number from 0 - 72, enabling high payouts at an increased house edge.
- Two concentric roulette number rings appear on the display, spinning in opposite directions



At 'No More Bets' both rings stop, randomly aligning the numbers.



The winning roulette number then determines which two numbers are added together to make the final Spread-Bet value. Players bet on the spread into which this value falls.



HOW TO PLAY

- Spread-Bets are placed at the beginning of each game alongside (or instead of) traditional roulette bets. The Billboard Display shows the winning value and spread. Bets are paid out and collected at the end of the game.
